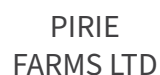

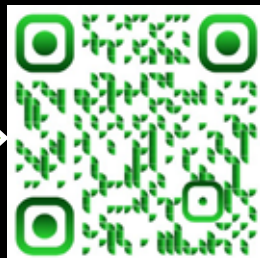

Michael Jenkins says it is an honour to be asked to officiate the next generation of rising stars. Michael was introduced to Holsteins through his parents, Roger and Sue Jenkins, of Membury Holsteins. Adding fuel to the fire lit by their genetics was exposure to some of the great studs within the New Zealand including names like Cairnhill (Trevor and Rosalie Zanders), Kauri Glen (Tony Barton), Belrose (Gary Colquhoun), Oak Lodge (Rennie family), and Karatane (Ormsby family).

“With that kind of influence, it was easy to fall in love with quality dairy cows,” Michael said.

Michael showed for the first time when he was eight years old and he took his own string when he was aged 13. In 2010, together with his wife, Holly, they started their own stud – Lucerne Holsteins.

They dispersed in 2022, and no longer live on a dairy farm.

“But the passion for cows is still very much part of our lives. We’re raising three amazing teenagers, and I feel lucky that the dairy industry has played such a big role in shaping our family,” Michael said.

Some personal highlights include winning Champion Cow at

the Waikato Show four times and Reserve Champion three times. Michael has judged on-farm competitions in Canterbury, Hawke’s Bay and Southland, as well as the North Island Championships in Stratford.

Today, he is the Business Development Manager for Bell-Booth, travelling around New Zealand, visiting farms and supporting farmers.

“I still love exhibiting cattle with my brother, Tony, and his wife Serena, who share the same passion as I do.

“Cows have given me and my family lifelong friendships – both here in New Zealand – and across the Tasman.

“I wish all the competitors the very best of luck. I can’t wait to see the animals and line them up.”

Gabrielle was born into the Ayrshire world and has grown up within the show industry, helping prepare the Brookview stock before she established her own stud Simplee Ayrshires. Although Ayrshires have her heart she appreciates a good animal from any breed.

NZ DairyEvent 2025, Gabby went in partnership to buy the winning Ayrshire junior calf. She lead that calf to the top of the line and her very own bred calf came close behind placing second.

Gabby started judging animals at a young age, for a while she would simply choose the ‘friendly’ animals, in her young teens she told her father “I really like that cow”, he shrugged her off until classification came around and that cow scored among the highest of her age group. That was when it was decided that Gabby would attend judging schools. She was an unofficial associate judge under Roger Hutchings at Te Kawhata show when she was around 15. Her latest show that she was an associate for was Stratford A&P under Derek Hayward in 2024.

Gabby has participated in the Ayrshire Young judging competition for many years, winning the Arran Trophy in 2025. She looks forward to expanding her knowledge under Michael Jenkins.

Wayne Kuhne – of Bushlea Jersey fame which has won Grand Champion Jersey five times at Australia's International Dairy Week (IDW) – will judge the Jerseys.

Wayne and wife Lisa are the third generation to operate Bushlea Farms at Koonwarra in South Gippsland. They milk 420 seasonal calving cows (over a 10-12-week period once-a-year). Wayne has been a board member of Jersey Australia for the last six years, and he is the current chair of its Genetic and Breed Development.

Wayne's involvement in the South Gippsland Jersey breeders club spans more than 30 years, and he is its current president.

Showing, promoting, and selling Jersey cattle has been an integral part of Bushlea's business for many years - along with a strong commercial focus under Wayne's stewardship.

It's hard to know which name is better known in world Jerseys circles - Bushlea (the farm), Fernleaf (the cow family that helped put Bushlea on the map),

or Kuhne (the tightknit family behind it all) – take your pick.

In addition to IDW broad ribbons, Bushlea has won Champion Cow at the Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane Royals. It has also been the name on multiple high-sellers throughout a profile career for this popular family. Notably, Bushlea sold Bushlea Van Fernleaf 10 EX93 for AUD\$50,000 – an Australasian record price – at the Global Impact Sale in 2017 after she had won Grand Champion Jersey at IDW before the sale. She went on to secure her IDW back-to-back Grand Champion title in 2018 for the international syndicate that bought her.

Wayne is quick to acknowledge the opportunities Jerseys have afforded him.

He judged the 2025 Central Gippsland Jerseys Fair (which coincided with the World Jersey Tour), the 2023 Great Northern Jersey Challenge, the 2023 Brisbane Royal Show, the 2019 New South Wales State Jersey Show, the 2019 Sydney Royal, the 2017 Gatton QLD

State Show, various features shows throughout Victoria, and the Waikato On-Farm Competition.

Wayne and Lisa have a daughter, Ruby, who is studying Year 12.

Boldview Ayrshires needs no introduction within the Ayrshire fraternity. Scott Braendler (together with his sister, Cheryl Liebeck) are the co-owners and managers of South Australian family operation, which includes Cher-Bar Ayrshires. In a unique twist, 20% of the herd includes animals from 28 other studs – who rely on Boldview to keep their interest in the breed alive by housing their show animals.

Boldview is also Australia's biggest Ayrshire herd – milking up to 420 Ayrshires, 25 Jerseys, seven Holsteins, and two Illawarras – through a 60-unit rotary. It is also one of the most successful Ayrshire breeders and exhibitors in Australia, winning significant numbers of championships at its hometown Royal – Adelaide – along with International Dairy Week, and at local country shows.

Its Adelaide Show teams are renowned for being exceptionally big – and for representing the many exhibitors. Boldview helps sustain an interest in the breed by showing on their behalf. Boldview has also won many All-Australian and All-World Photo Competition winners.

In December 2018, the home farm relocated to a 270ha property at Mount McIntyre, in the south-east region of South Australia, which has a 27-inch rainfall (and underground aquifers via three centre pivots and 40ha of fixed sprinklers). It recently bought an additional 160ha of dryland for silage production and heifer growing.

Scott held Federal positions on Australian Ayrshire Committees between 2004 and 2020 – including four years as

Treasurer of AABA Inc, and four years as President of AABA Inc. During his presidency, Australia hosted the 2020 World Ayrshire Federation Conference Tour. In 2017, Scott was awarded Life Membership of Australian Ayrshires Ltd.

She doesn't come from a farming background, and she has nurtured her passion for Ayrshire cattle through the show rings of Northland and Auckland. She owns 11 cows under the Inca prefix. She recently achieved her first homebred Excellent classification with Inca Pinnacle – who is out of her first homebred heifer to win an A&P show championship, Inca Bur Piper.

Courtney is a passionate advocate for dairy, and she was the youngest elected member to serve a term on the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand Executive. She has also represented New Zealand as the Rural Ambassador in Australia. Her interest in livestock stretches her resume to include representing New Zealand as a dairy, beef, poultry and merino judge across

GENERAL RULES & NOTICES

To be run under the Rules of the Manawatu A&P Association Show Rules and Regulations: <https://www.ras.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/2022/03/Showing-Rules-Regulations-2020-21.pdf>

YOUTH SHOW

1. Youth Exhibitors must be aged under 18 years as at the 01/01/2026. All animals entered in the Youth Section are eligible to be shown in their respective Breed's and the All Breed's Sections and must be entered and led by the Youth Exhibitor in all the sections.
2. Handlers Classes: Only calves and yearlings are to be used, also the same animal cannot be used by more than one exhibitor/handler.
3. Team Challenge: This event is for non-professionals; in this context a professional is a person that travels from or to other countries to prepare cattle for sale or shows and is paid for his/her services.

ALL NZ SHOW

1. The one Entry fee per animal automatically enters that animal in all classes it is eligible.
2. The NZ DairyEvent Organising Committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes with insufficient entries or extend classes with very large entries, any decision made by the committee will be final.

LATE ENTRIES

May be accepted. Acceptance will be at the discretion of the NZ DairyEvent Organising Committee.

1. All accepted late entries will be subject to a late entry fee of Class entry fee + 50% ie. \$30 + 50%, Total \$45.
2. Replacement within a class is permitted but between classes is not permitted.

SUBSTITUTES

These will only be accepted for cattle in the same breed and same aged class.

CLIPPING FRAMES

1. These are permitted, there is a charge of \$100 + GST for a frame site/per frame and the frame will be situated next to your cattle.
2. Clipping space must be booked and paid for on the entry form. If not booked and paid for at time of entry no frame will be permitted to be erected.
3. To be fair to all exhibitors, clipping frames must be erected in the space allocated by the committee, not where the exhibitor thinks it should be.
4. A limit of 2 clipping frames per aisle.

STRAW/BEDDING

1. Each isle will be allocated sawdust.
2. Sawdust is available for bedding; however, straw can be used at the exhibitor's own cost.
3. Sponsor Farm Source (Ph: 06 323 9146) will have shavings available at exhibitor's own cost.

EARLY ARRIVING CATTLE

Exhibitors that are traveling extreme distances will be permitted to enter Manfeild early by approval from **Chief Steward Jamie Cunninghame (027 583 3533)**. Contact must be made to Jamie with day and time of arrival for approval. All other exhibitors will be able to enter Manfield on Saturday 24 January 2026.

RULES

1. **Unacceptable behavior, drunkenness and under-age drinking will not be permitted.** Alcohol is not to be visible to the public.
2. Any alteration of conformation of cattle as per the Manawatu A&P Assn rules will be considered malpractice and could be disqualified from the event.
3. It is expected all exhibitors will always keep their stalls clean and tidy and encourage those that want to dress up their stalls please do so.
4. All rubbish is to be placed in the rubbish bins provided and all cattle waste, saw-dust, shavings etc. to be placed in the allocated/signed areas/bins provided. **It is the exhibitors Responsibility to keep their area clean and tidy - this includes when packing out from the event.**
5. Exhibitors are asked to **NOT** bring large bales of baleage inside the stadium.
6. No dogs allowed in the stadium, day, or night.
7. As a Manfield Park requirement there is to be **NO GLASS BOTTLES** on the premises. No glassware/glass bottles are allowed inside the stadium.

These are magnificent facilities; with the level of visitors, we need to keep our image of being first class at all time's first class! **"Failure to respect the facility could jeopardize our event for the future."**

BY-LAWS

1. All cattle in the breed sections must be entered in the name of the bona-fide owner.
2. The date of birth of all breeding cattle must be stated at the time of entry.
3. The age of cattle shall be computed as of 1st June. NB: As the age of all cattle is determined from the 1st of June in each year, all animals shall be deemed to be one year older on this date.

4. All cattle entered in the Breed and Youth classes, if one-year-old or over, must be entered in the recognized Herd Book of the breed concerned. If under one year of age, they must be eligible for entry.
5. Addition to by-laws as approved by the NZDE:
 - “Animals eligible for showing at NZDE must be registered with their individual breed society and comply with their individual breed society rules for association showing awards.”

TB TESTING & NAIT REQUIREMENTS

1. All cattle including calves and yearlings entered for this Show must be from a TB free and Accredited herd and tested within the Opsri Regulations of your region.
2. Cattle from a TB free and accredited herd within a declared movement control area must be tested and passed within 60 days of movement. **A copy of the test certificate must accompany all Animals.**
3. Checks will be made for TB declaration cards on stock arrival.
4. A NAIT approved RFID tag is mandatory for all movements of cattle, including calves. NAIT regulations for ear tagging is one registered NAIT tag per animal for animals 30 days or older.
5. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to record all animal movements with NAIT 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the Event and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the event.
6. The animals must be transferred to the **(Manawatu A&P NAIT number - 443920)** for the event.
7. ALL cattle must have Animal Health Board or Birth ID Tags.
8. The Committee will inspect animal identification to establish TB and NAIT status.

STALLING OF ENTRIES

1. In the event of cataloged entries not being exhibited at the Show, the Chief Steward shall have the right to re-allocate such stall spaces.
2. Feed receptacles will not be provided in the Dairy Pavilion.
3. Exhibitors wishing to feed meal or dry stock foods should bring suitable containers with them.
4. Hoses will be located at the end of each row in the Pavilion.

Water troughs need to be supplied by the exhibitors and are not to be shared between exhibitors as a precaution for the prevention of the transmission of Mycoplasma Bovis.

5. The Chief Steward along with the NZ DairyEvent Committee has the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the event if they fail to comply with the rules of both the NZ DairyEvent and Manfeild Park.

HEALTH AND SAFETY:

1. All exhibitors and visitors are expected to comply with the Health and Safety Act 2015.
2. All exhibitors and visitors are expected to comply with the any National Health regulations at the time of the event.
3. A shed meeting will be held at the start of the event to outline evacuation procedures.

In the event of an emergency, exhibitors are asked to follow the instructions of NZDE Committee members and Manfield Park staff.

4. Exhibitors will be asked for their Current First Aid certification (if they have it) on the Entry Form. This will assist with the Health & Safety aspects at the event.
5. **Electrical equipment** must be approved for use by a registered electrician and carry an 'Electrical Safety Test label' valid for the period of the event. The NZDE Committee strongly advises that to avoid disappointment exhibitors get electrical equipment tested before arriving.

SHED MEETING

1. A Shed Meeting will be held at the start of the event: **5.30pm Sunday 25th January 2026**
2. Attendance from all exhibitors and supporters is **compulsory** at this meeting.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

In case an exhibitor has a (perceived) **conflict of interest** arising from his/her participation in any classes of the Youth Show or Breeds sections of the New Zealand DairyEvent, he/she will have to declare this conflict to the **Chief Steward** for consideration prior to the exhibitor entering the ring (allowing sufficient time for the chief steward to decide on the matter). If the chief steward considers the conflict of interest 'significant', he will appoint an independent judge (i.e. the I.C.E. judge) to have the final say on the top 6 placings in that class and/or subsequent championship classes. Examples of a conflict of interest could be:

1. The exhibitor is showing an animal that was bred by the judge
2. The exhibitor is personally a close relation of the judge
3. The animal shown was/is owned by the judge
4. The animal is directly owned or in partnership with the judge
5. Etc. others?

The **onus is on the exhibitor** to come forward in a timely manner with their (perceived) conflict of interest. **Failure to disclose** any (perceived) conflict of interest will be dealt with by the chief steward and could result in the exhibitor's results being annulled. The final decision on any (perceived) conflict of interest will be made by the chief steward and no correspondence in regards to his decision will be entered into.

CODE OF PRACTICE

The NZ DairyEvent Organising Committee have determined the following Codes of Practice under the rules of The Royal Agricultural Society (RAS).

The showing of registered pedigree cattle is an important part of the promotion, merchandising and breeding programme of many breeders. Additionally, it is an important part of the programme of the NZ DairyEvent to stimulate and sustain interest in breeding registered pedigree cattle. This relates to both spectators and exhibitors. In this connection, the Organising Committee of the NZ DairyEvent (NZDE) believes that it is in the best interests of the breeders of registered pedigree cattle to maintain a reputation of integrity and to present a wholesome and progressive image of their cattle in the show ring.

NZDE recognizes that there are certain practices in the proper care and management of dairy cattle that are necessary while moving dairy cattle to and between shows that is advisable to keep them in a sound, healthy condition so that they might be presented in the show ring in a natural, normal appearance and condition. Conversely, it recognizes certain practices in the handling and presentation of cattle in the show ring that are unacceptable.

In keeping with the basic philosophy of the NZ DairyEvent, ethics are an individual responsibility of the owner of each animal shown. Violations of these policies are subject to the disciplinary action of the NZDE's Rules.

The following practices or procedures are considered unacceptable and defined as being fraudulent and/or unethical in the showing of registered pedigree cattle.

- Misrepresenting the age and/or milking status of the animal for the class in which it is entered/shown.

- Treating the animal, particularly the udder, internally or externally with an irritant or counterirritant.
- Surgically or insertion of foreign matter under the skin, performed to change the natural contour or appearance of the animal's body, though not to preclude practices required or involved in normal management.
- Criticizing or interfering with the judge, show management or other exhibitors while in the show ring, or other conduct detrimental to the animal's breed or the NZDE All NZ Show.
- Setting teats or manipulation of a teat to alter its normal position such as to unnaturally hold it plumb or to alter its length, is unacceptable and shall be regarded as malpractice.
- It will be the responsibility of All New Zealand Show judges at the NZDE to take appropriate action if any teats are set, or in any way manipulated to an unnatural position.
- While all milking animals must be subject to examination, the judge/s will be instructed to closely examine the top five animals, not only for set teats but for any other form of tampering requiring discrimination or disqualification.
- The following is considered to detract from the image of the show ring when carried to excess and will be given slight to serious discrimination in placing animals within a class. This would be seen as unsportsmanlike conduct on the part of the show person.

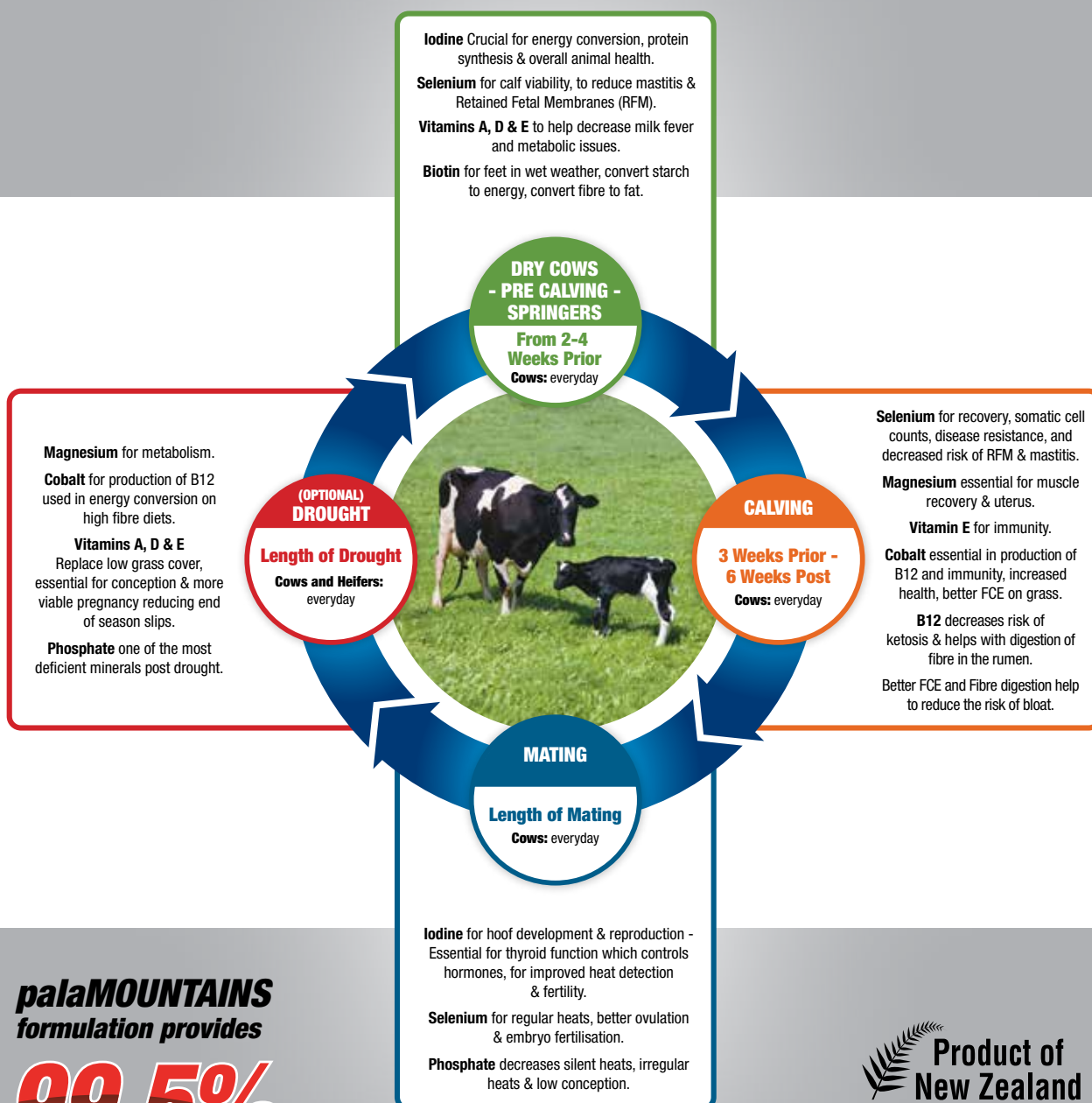

RULES FOR FUTURITY CLASSES

Futurity classes will be run under the General Rules of the Dairy Cattle Sections governed by both Waikato A&P Show and NZ DairyEvent.

In addition to the General rules governed by both Waikato A&P Show and NZ DairyEvent the following rules shall apply to calf, yearling heifer and two year old in milk Futurity classes.

1. Only heifer calves born from the 1st June 2023 purchased at the Next Generation Sale or the Summer Sensation Sale are eligible to enter.
2. A one off entry fee of \$100 per animal is to be paid by the purchaser at the time of the Next Generation Sale or the Summer Sensation Sale. (Revenue generated from the sale of Futurity Lots and any additional money from donors received on the day of the Next Generation Sale or Summer Sensation Sale will be held secure in a BNZ term deposit. Final two year old in milk Futurity classes will be held in October 2026 at Waikato A&P Show and January 2026 at NZ DairyEvent. The monies generated at the Next Generation Sale in 2023 and the sale of Futurity Lots at the Summer Sensation Sale 2026 will become the prize pool for the in milk two year old Futurity classes. The prize pool will be equally divided between Waikato A&P Show and NZ DairyEvent.)
3. All in milk two year olds exhibited in the two year old in milk Futurity class will receive a percentage of the prize pool. Allocated percentages of winnings in order of placing.
4. Whereby calf and yearling Futurity classes have been sponsored then the sponsored prizes/monies shall be paid to the said class.
5. Whereby calf and yearling classes have been sponsored by the Breed Associations in the form of cash or prize of any kind payable to the youth handler, then that cash or prize shall remain the property of the youth handler it has been awarded to.
6. Ribbons will be placed 1st – 6th for Futurity calf, yearling and two year old in milk classes.
7. All calves, yearling's and in milk two year olds must be paraded by persons who were aged 25 years and under on the day the animal was purchased as a calf at the Next Generation Sale or the Summer Sensation Sale.
8. Failing the nominated youth handler being unable to exhibit the calf, yearling or in milk two year old, another youth handler may be nominated. Notification of the change must be given to the Chief Steward prior to the calf, heifer or in milk two year old entering the ring.
9. Proof of age of any youth handler may be requested from time to time by the Ring Steward.
10. Any additional fees imposed by both Waikato A&P Show and NZ DairyEvent or levies collected for a third party remain the responsibility of the owner.
11. Rules should be read in conjunction with the Next Generation Sale rules.
12. The Organising Committee reserves the right to review and amend the rules at any time. Committee members; Matt Satherley, Duncan Pipe (027 264 9527), Wendy Harker, Brian Robinson (027 241 0051) Heather Fowlie (027 452 1416) and NZ DairyEvent Representatives.
